Our prayer is that this letter finds you convicted of your sin, confident in your salvation, and constantly striving in gospel labor. Summer has faded here in Kenya, and the nearly uncomfortable 85°F heat is finally giving way to a livable 68°-72° (sarcasm).

In March, the long rainy season made its powerful appearance in Kenya. The downpours turned streets into rivers and swept away many people, vehicles, and makeshift slum houses. Tragically, at least 70 people lost their lives in the flash floods. We are incredibly thankful that the worst we suffered was a flooded back yard and a loss of power for a few days.

During the remainder of March and through April, we had the pleasure of hosting multiple guests! Amber's parents were the first to visit, and we had a lovely time touring Nairobi with them and introducing our friends and church. They even endured the traffic chaos of CBD (Central Business District) in Nairobi thanks to Ben taking a wrong turn.

Ben's Dad also enjoyed his visit for three weeks in April. While here, he tackled several projects including building a small chair for Andy and fixing several of our shelves. In addition, he traded in his hammer and tape measure for a rivet gun and safety glasses as he helped Ben for a few days installing

flap tracks on the Cessna Caravan that is undergoing its 20,000hr inspection. Our final victims (oops sorry, I mean visitors) were John and Jamey from Faith Bible Church. They bumped along with us through Nairobi game park and brought us so much encouragement and joy during their trip. Praise God for impactful visits and smooth travel.

The war in Iran has had deep impacts here in Kenya. The price of fuel has skyrocketed, causing an uproar in the public transport sector. This led to a Matatu (public transport buses) strike in mid-May which then led to rioting. The Kenyan government has since lowered the cost of fuel slightly, but tensions

are still high. Praise for God keeping us safe during this time.

Finally, we will be returning to the U.S. June 5th to celebrate the marriage of Amber's brother Daniel. We will also be visiting Cascade for a short stint before returning to Africa. Pray that God would give Amber and I patience and grace as we try to survive multiple 10+ hour flights with a 17-month-old sinner, and that our fellowship with our families would be sweet.
